HopeforEverybody.com is 1) building the largest network of providers, 2) connecting them with those in need (a "Client"), 3) generating sustainable revenue that will be able to support those on the front line, those in need and the ones who met the needs. "Pocket Change" Grants are awarded to those who join the effort to build and sustain HopeforEverybody.

PURPOSE: From the front-end, it will be a place for those in need (Clients) and those who could meet their needs (Providers) to meet in a facebook-like format. From the backend, it will be a simplified, streamlined, online case management system for the Providers to be able to track those they are helping AND, if they subscribe at a higher level, to be able to receive information about anyone in the system, who they are, what help they've received and what individual or organization has provided it. Similar in concept to the Medical Information Bureau.

Again, think facebook on the front end but for the purpose of 1) building a national database of individuals, businesses and organizations providing services to the least, the last and the lost (Providers), 2) connecting people in need (Clients) with Providers, 3) generating sustainable revenue through data driven analytics, sales and marketing, and any other way we can devise, 4) giving back through "pocket change" grants awarded to clients and providers who are making the most difference in their community, making the most "change," 5) creating a universal, case management system for non-profits to track their efforts and to prevent fraud, waste and abuse.

Clients will help build the database of providers by referring them to the website. Providers may sign up as well. Clients and providers will receive "pocket change" grants for, respectively, recommending providers and meeting needs.

WHERE TO BEGIN?

Step One: build the body (the website and databases)

Users sign up to create social pages similar to facebook

Users help build databases, rising within the body from novice, noticed, nice, noble, guide, to mentor collecting community prizes along the way (merit badges, certificates, etc., free digital stuff, and earn money from "pocket change" grants. For example: User found job and enters employer info, earns a star or something, status progresses, found a landlord who rents to offenders, enters their info, presto! Another award! Awards eventually lead to "pocket change" grants, cash awards for their diligence in referring Providers.

Step Two: The website databases feed for-profit website databases; the data received is scrubbed, checked, made live.



Step Three: Salespeople contact non-profits about subscribing to the case management backend AND businesses entered about customizing their listing, advertising, building out their page

WEBSITE INTRO CONCEPT/TEXT

In I Corinthians 12 The Apostle Paul teaches us that the body has many members, every member is important, and no member can say another isn't needed. Ultimately, this is true because we are the body of Christ, and Christ is our Head. Paul also wrote that Christians are called to comfort others with the comfort we've received. The body needs you. Heres how it works:

You create a page introducing yourself to the Body, the Body of Christ and others. Everybody has needs. The organizers of this site believe, first, EverybodyNeedsGod (Matthew 6:33-34) but people also need food, clothing, shelter, employment, healthcare, etc. As you find an individual or resource that meets a need for you, please post about that individual or resource so The Body knows who to call, where to go. HopeForEverybody will connect clients with providers, and reward both in the process!

Community guides will verify the information to confirm the person or provider desires to be listed. If they do, their information will go live so others may learn about them also. Over time, the prayer is that we will build a network of people and places that will help meet the needs of the body. This will truly be a source of Hope for Everybody!

HopeforEverybody is founded by Christians who are unashamed of the gospel of Jesus Christ. But, because the Great Commission and a cultural mandate are given to every Christian to be the light in an otherwise dark world, this organization, its providers and services, are open to the public and will not discriminate. Provider Home Page - profile info, referrals reviewed, interaction recorded, referrals marked open, in process, closed

Community Functionality

Community Bulletin Board / chat (restricted from SOs)

Classifieds (think craigslist, posts may be flagged, some categories are chargeable)

Case Management where Providers can interact with and notate client files

Providers and services provided are visible to other providers. Client files may be flagged/red tagged which serves to indicate a problem client / repeat offender, indicating a provider should call the other provider before providing services

HopeforEverybody.org will...

- Be a Social Network (think facebook) for change
- Should be web and app based
- Provide "Pocket Change" grants to those in need (Clients—for helping build the database) and those who meet their needs (Providers—for meeting the needs)
- Create and build the largest, fee-based Case Management tool in the non-profit world (think Medical Information Bureau—the purpose of which will be to enable Providers to be able to keep track of who gives what to whom and to notate the Client file)
 - Consider private labeling the Case Management Software
- Create and build databases that feed for-profit websites serving the needs of the Providers and Clients
- Free for Clients, Fee based for providers after the first 90 days
 - \$10/mo. for non-profits with less than 25 clients.
 - \$25/mo. for non-profits with 26 to 50 clients.



- \$50/mo. for non-profits with 51 100 clients.
- \$100/mo. for non-profits with 101 + clients
- Regional Database Access? Call for pricing.
- National Database Access? Call for pricing.

The end results front end should be similar to: Home (oxfordvacancies.com)

- 1. Property owner (PO) creates an account
- 2. PO lists properties
- --property name
- --address
- --number of bedrooms
- --number of beds per room

--rent by bed, bedroom or entire property (some transitional/2nd chance landlords may rent out a house or an apartment, while others (like us) actually rent bed space in the bedroom, the landlord needs to be able to select this when setting up the property

--pics

--property description

--prospective tenant or actual tenant's name and contact information (assignable from application if using our online version, visible only to the landlord, estimated date of arrival and/or leaving)

--comments

3. Uses standardized, online application or uploads his own PDF

4. Gets his own directory like transitionalhousing.com/propertyowner which he can then use to manage his rentals

- 5. Mobile friendly so he knows his occupancy/availability
- 6. Allows online rent payments to him (we collect a percentage of each transaction)
